PUBLIC ACCOUNTABILITY AND REPORTING PROJECT (PARP) – 2019 FIRST REPORT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Thank you for the submission of the BC Broiler Hatching Egg Commission's (Broiler Hatching Egg Commission) PARP report by the extended timeline of June 21, 2019. The British Columbia Farm Industry Review Board (BCFIRB) appreciates the work done by your board and staff in preparing this report and contributing to this important initiative.

This report is an important step towards supporting and demonstrating effective governance and sound leadership of the regulated agricultural sectors.

The Broiler Hatching Egg Commission's report reflects an organized approach to the regulation of the industry and Commission governance. Areas where further governance work is needed were identified and public work action plans were highlighted. Presentation of the quota management and movement data was complete and provided a transparent overview of the BC hatching egg industry's structure.

BCFIRB is currently in the process of reviewing the eight commodity board PARP reports and will be publishing a summary of the eight reports in the near future.
