DISMISSAL ORDER

WHEREAS:

- The Appellant, Primary Poultry Processors Association of British Columbia, filed six related appeals against decisions of the British Columbia Chicken Marketing Board.
 - N2103 – Filed May 10, 2021: Pricing Order #160 (Period A-169), includes a request for an exceptional circumstance determination.
 - N2104 – Filed June 26, 2021: Pricing Order #161 (Period A-170).
 - N2105 – Filed August 25, 2021: Pricing Order #162 (Period A-171).

- N2106 – Filed October 25, 2021: Pricing Order #163 (Period A-172).
 - N2109 – Filed December 17, 2021: Pricing Order #164 (Period A-173).
 - N2214 – Filed February 16, 2022: Pricing Order #165 (Period A-174)
- On February 2, 2026, the Appellant, Primary Poultry Processors Association of British Columbia, withdrew all six of its appeals.
 - Section 17 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, SBC 2004, c. 45 provides if an appellant withdraws an appeal, the tribunal must order that the appeal is dismissed.

THEREFORE THIS BOARD ORDERS:

- That the six appeals filed by Primary Poultry Processors Association of British Columbia of the decisions of the British Columbia Chicken Marketing Board are dismissed.
